Dr. Veronica Kinsler studied Medicine at Cambridge University graduating in 1994 (MA MB BChir), and took post-graduate Paediatrics qualifications in 1997 (MRCPCH).

She developed an interest in Paediatric Dermatology early in her career, through working at Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children (GOSH) in London.

She obtained a PhD in Molecular Genetics from UCL. She is the academic lead clinician for the Paediatric Dermatology department at GOSH, and undertakes her research within the Clinical and Molecular Genetics Unit at the neighbouring UCL Institute of Child Health.

Her research has focused on the clinical and genetic characterisation of pigmentary abnormalities in children and congenital melanocytic naevi and their associated complications.

More recently she has established the GOSH rare dermatology diseases resource, a tissue bank for facilitation of research into all rare diseases seen in the GOSH department.
